

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### "Turk": Nation's Name or an Ethnic Group's Name?

- 1934 Settlement Law: "Turkish race" 6 times
- 2006 Settlement Law art. 4 "Not to be admitted as immigrants: Aliens who are not from Turkish descent (Türk soyundan) and not attached to Turkish culture"
- 1979, Mr. Ş. Elçi, then a Minister: "There are Kurds in Turkey, and I am one of them" 4 years and 7 months.
- In 1997, Ms. M. Akşener, then a Minister, for Mr. A. Öcalan: "Armenian sperm". No investigation. Penal Law art. 301: "Anyone who openly denigrates the Turkish Nation... from 6 months to 2 years".
  - Could it then be said that the term "Turkish Nation" encompasses all ethnic groups in Turkey?
  - Could it then be then that this article 301 precludes the denigration of Turkish citizens of Armenian or Kurdish descent?

Last minute news: Court of Cassation: 1) "Any Turkish citizen can sue Orhan Pamuk"; 2) "5 Kurds against 1 soldier" acquitted.

- Are Kurds, Turk?
  - If "yes", what is "Kurdish Problem"?
  - If "no", what is "Turkish Nation"? .

### "Turk": Nation's Name or a Religious Group's Name?

- The Court of Cassation in 1971, 74, 75: "Foundations founded by non-Turks cannot acquire real-estate in Turkey"
- 1988 By-laws for Prevention of Sabotages, citing dangerous categories: "Domestic Foreigners (Turkish citizens) inside the country".
- 1996 Istanbul Administrative Court, for a non-Muslim citizen: "Foreign subject Turkish citizen".
- Until 2007, Law no. 625, art. 24: "Vice principal to be appointed to foreign [and minority] schools will be a Turkish citizen of Turkish descent"
- Could it then be said that the term "Turkish Nation" encompasses all religious groups in Turkey?
  - If "yes", how to explain all these laws and cases cited above?
  - If "no", what is "Turkish Nation"?
  - How can all this happen in a very laicist country? .

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### Minds Are Very Confused:

Cases from Political and Judicial Life

- 2004 official Minority Report: "Supra-identity should be 'Türkiyeli' instead of 'Turk' 5 years for "openly inciting people to hate and enmity".
- 2007: Three Protestants tortured and killed by youngsters for "missionary activities". The
  indictment is composed of 32 folders: 8 for the case proper, 24 for missionary activities.
  Is spreading one's religion prohibited in Turkey?
  - If "no", that indictment is supposed to indict who? The murderers or the victims?
  - If "yes", what is then the General Directorate of [Muslim] Religious Affairs?
- 2008: Court of Cassation acquitted an MP who insulted the responsibles of the Minority Report by saying: "Let them ask their mother to find out who their father is"
- 2008: Mr Alınak, former MP, has spent several sentences of 6 months in prison for using the letters: q, x, w. In this case, how many years should be inflicted on the Ministry of Interior and on Turkish Armed Forces for: <a href="www.icisleri.gov.tr">www.icisleri.gov.tr</a> and <a href="www.tsk.gov.tr">www.tsk.gov.tr</a>?
- On the other hand, two last minute news: 1) Parents who named their daughter "Hevi Jiyan" (hopeful life) are under investigation; 2) Parents officially named their daughter: "Helin Kurdistan" (the nest of K.)
- · Under these circumstances:
  - Does "Turk" have an anti Kurdish and anti non-Muslim meaning?
  - Is "Turk" an ethno-religious concept?
  - Is "Secular Sunni-Hanefi-Muslim-Turk" (LAHASÜMÜT) the definition of WASP in Turkey?







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# Why Such a Confusion?

- 1) Supra-identity and Infra-identity relations,
- 2) The "Sevres Paranoia" and its Zombies,
- 3) The "Dominant Nation" ideology,
- 4) The rattling rate of the modernization process.





### 2) The Sevres Paranoia

- · Summary of the Paranoia:
  - "Christian and imperialist West wants to colonize us again",
  - The Kurds want to dismember Turkey,
  - "The Islamists will force our daughters to wear the veil",
- · Reasons of the Paranoia:
  - Reaction to globalization (EU Reforms)
  - Fear of the four Zombies: Kurdish, Armenian, Islam, Cyprus questions
  - Fear of losing privileges
  - Reaction to Islamophobia in the EU
  - Actual developments: A Kurdish "State" in N. Iraq, PKK ends cease-fire, etc.
- The Result: "Chosen Trauma"
  - · Prescriptions of '30s are only inflaming the problems of 2000s,
  - New prescriptions would be just the opposite of '30s'
  - · Everything that people were taught and sure of is fading.














## The Millet System Is Transferred to the Republic

- The Dominant Millet: Muslim → Muslim Turk
- The Dominated Millets: Non-Muslims
- Very deeply rooted. Kurds and Alevis: "We are not minority; we are essential and founding element"
- The System has re-produced itself twice under the Republic:
  - 1923 Lausanne arts. 37-44 (1923), definition of minority: "Non-Muslims",
  - 1980 Turkish-Islamic Synthesis: "Muslim Turk",

### Conclusion

- In Turkey the real conflict is not between:
  - Turk and Kurds
  - Left and Right
  - Sunnis and Alevis
  - Muslims and non-Muslims
  - Laicists and Islamists
  - Progressives and Reactionaries, etc.
- The conflict is between the Two Waves of Modernization: Clash of Modernizations.
